Eighth Annual Juried Exhibit of Paintings
April 9th – May 2nd, 2010

These entries should reflect artist wide variety of styles. The juror will be looking for works of art that challenge the viewer through artistic ability, creativity and imagination.

ELGIBILITY

- **Members and non members of Allied Arts.**
- **Two dimensional arts accepted.**
- **All works of art must be executed within the last two years & be original.**
- **No work will be accepted that is from other artist's work, photographs or published material.**
- **Watercolor (includes gouache etc.), oil, acrylic, mixed, pastel, encaustic and collage are accepted but no digital work.**

AWARDS

- **First prize: \$300.00, Second prize: \$200.00, Third prize: \$100.00,**
- **Audrey Coglin Award: \$75.00, Honorable Mentions: \$50.00 each.**

SALES AND FEES

- **Allied Art Association shall retain a 30% commission on any sales.**
- **There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$15.00 per item for Allied Arts members and \$25.00 for non members.**
- **A flat fee of \$10.00 is required if unable to serve as a docent.**
- **Only two entries per artist.**
- **All work must be for sale.**
- **Up to 5 matted pieces per artist may be placed in bins for a single show with an entry fee of \$1.00 each. Card fee is \$1.00 for 10 cards. These will not be juried.**
- **All work must be picked up on time. \$5.00 a day will be charged for storage. After 30 days it becomes the property of AAA to be disposed of as appropriate.**
- **Payment for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist's current address at the end of each month for amounts of ten dollars or more.**

ARTIST RESPONSIBILITY

- **Provide a current biography or artist statement for the Artist Information Binder.**
- **Artists in the show are expected to help staff the gallery during the show.**
- **All artwork must be signed in and out on an itemized inventory list by the artist or their agent on exchange days only.**

REQUIREMENTS FOR SHOWING WORK

- Paintings must be wired straight across the back, approximately 1/3rd down from the top and the wire must be taut.
- Wrap-around canvasses don't have to be framed if painted on side & no staples are shown.
- Encaustic paintings don't have to be framed.
- Paintings with mats must be matted in white or off-white.
- Use acrylic, not glass, for larger paintings.
- CAA reserves the right to reject work which is not dry, not properly wired, or of a size and weight not appropriate. Works that are unsuitable or don't meet the criteria for the show may also be rejected.
- Non juried bin work and cards may be brought in at the same time as the show. Please inquire about Bin/Card Policy on the Web page or gallery for details.
