Please come early, and be prepared to start. Workshop opens at 9:00.**

Anyone can do this. We will take an ordinary book and turn it into something you create from inside yourself and has meaning. Just come with a creative spirit and it will happen.

What to Bring

Bring a hardbound book you want to alter. It can be a book you want to add to or enhance the subject matter, or one that you will change entirely to fit your own subject. A book with sewn signatures is preferable.

Materials to bring

The essentials:

- Metal ruler
- Exacto knife and sharp blades
- Roll of wax paper
- scissors
- bone folder
- cutting board or heavy cardboard to cut upon
- 1" paste brush
- scrap paper to paste on
- small water container
- clean rags/paper towels

Now the fun items:

- Decorative papers and/or tissue papers
- Embellishments of any kind
- Colored markers or calligraphy pens, or colored pencils
- acrylic paint and brush (color you might want to use in your book)
- ink and pen
- A brick if you have one (to weigh down pages when drying)
- rubber stamp(s) and stamp pad(s) one or two favorites

ANYTHING else you typically use or gravitate to in your artwork. You will use only some of the above, so bring what you like.

Sharing Table

If you have extra, bring decorative papers or embellishments to share and inspire others as they work. A small piece might be just the thing for someone else, just as you might find something for your book.

The **Cambria Library** Book Sale is Feb 5th and 6th. Books are sold about \$1.50/inch. It's a great way to find a book to work on. Some are even *free* in the foyer of the Vets Hall.
