In addition we invite all fiber artists to enter an accompanying juried show, submitting up to two items of any fiber technique, including, but not limited to, weaving, felting, knitting, basketry, braiding, crochet, surface design and shibori.

A juror will screen all items and make the selection of work in the show. Pieces will be evaluated on concept, design, technique and overall suitability of the technique and/or materials. Creativeness is encouraged.

**The show is co-sponsored by The Ball and Skein at 4070 Burton in Cambria.**

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- All wall-hung work must have attachments that can be used with regular gallery painting hangers.
- 3 dimensional works must come with their own display device.
- Limited cabinet space is available for smaller 3 dimensional items
- Pedestals will not be provided by Allied Arts.
- Your own mannequins and forms are permissible.
- All work accepted must remain for the duration of the show.
- Up to two pieces may be entered per artist.
- Pieces must be originally conceived and created by the artist and should be one of a kind.
- Project completion should be within the last three years.
- Dimensions should not be larger than 5 feet X 5 feet & not weigh more than 50 pounds.

## **SALES AND FEES**

- All work should be for sale.
- Allied Arts Association shall retain a 30% commission on any sales
- There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$15.00 per item for Allied Arts members. Non members are charged \$25.00.
- All work must be picked up on time. \$5.00 a day will be charged for storage. After 30 days it becomes the property of Allied Arts to be disposed of as appropriate.
- Displaying artists are expected to serve as a docent once during the show. If unable to serve as a docent, a single \$10.00 fee is required.
- Payment for works sold will be mailed to the artist's current address at the end of the month.

## **ARTIST RESPONSIBILITY**

- Provide a current biography or artist statement for the Artist Information Binder.
- Artist in the show are expected to help staff the gallery during the show.
- All artwork must be signed in and out on an itemized inventory list by the artist or their agent.
- Works will have appropriate hanging devices.
