Juror:

The Juror for selection of work and awards is Ruta Saliklis, Exhibition Director, San Luis Obispo Museum of Art. Ms. Saliklis has extensive curatorial experience from her work as Associate Director of the Ball State University Museum of Art and Curator of Textiles at the Allentown Art Museum. She holds a Ph.D. in Textiles and Design, MFA in Museum Studies and a B.A. in Comprehensive Studio Art. She has published numerous articles on art, design, textiles and fashion.

Eligibility:

Open to all artists. Membership in Allied Arts of Cambria is not required.

Two- and three-dimensional works will be considered.

A maximum of two pieces per artist may be entered.

All works must be executed within the last two years and be original.

Work may not be copied from another artist's work, photographs or published material.

Allied Arts reserves the right to reject work not an appropriate size and weight, not dry, or deemed not acceptable for the show.

First Prize: \$300

Second Prize: \$200

Third Prize: \$100

Audrey Coglín Award: \$ 75

Two Honorable Mentions: \$ 50

Calendar:

Feb. 7, 10:00 am to noon: intake of work.

Please use the back door.

Feb. 8, 10 am to noon: pick up pieces not selected. We will call after 4 pm on 2/7 to let you know your status.

2-dimensional work:

All media accepted.

Art must be wired straight across the back, approximately 1/3 down from the top and the wire must be taut.

Paintings must be framed, with the following exceptions: wrap-around paintings which are painted on all sides with no staples showing, paintings on board, so long as the sides are finished, encaustic paintings.

Max. framed size is 30"X30"; min. is 8" X 12".
Use acrylic, not glass, for large pieces.

Photography must be the original work of the artist.

3-dimensional work:

All media accepted.

Wall mounted 3-d pieces must be wired according to instructions for 2-d work.

Floor standing work must be free standing, stable and appropriate size for the space.

Work must not create a safety hazard.

You are responsible to deliver the work into the Gallery, and if needed, help set it up. If work is heavy or large, please bring the appropriate assistance and equipment.

Gallery pedestals are limited; but we will work with you to properly show your piece(s).

Responsibilities of artists:

All Artwork must be signed in and out on the inventory list by the artist or their agent on Exchange Days.

Provide a current biography or artist's statement for the Artist Information Binder.

Attend the opening reception if possible.

Artists are encouraged to volunteer to spend time in the Gallery to engage the public over the course of the show. You can sign up for time when you bring in your work.

Work must be picked up on time. \$5 a day will be charged for storage. After 30 days it becomes the property of Allied Arts of Cambria to be disposed of as appropriate.

Work may not be removed before show ends.

Sales:

All work must be for sale.

Allied Arts Association shall retain 30% commission on sales.

Payment for work sold will be mailed to the artist's address at the end of the show.

Sales will be handled by Allied Arts' Docent.

Entry Fees:

The non refundable entry fee is:

\$15 per piece for Allied Arts Members;

\$25 per piece for non-members.

You can join Allied Arts when you enter and take advantage of the Members Entry Fee. Limit of two entries per artist.

Up to 5 original matted pieces per artist may be placed in bins for duration of the show for a fee of \$2 per piece. These will not be juried.
