

**ALLIED ARTS ASSOCIATION GENERAL CALL FOR
ART AND
EXHIBITION OF FEATURED ARTIST,
LYNN RATHBUN**

July 9 - August 1, 2010

All artists are invited to display their art along with featured artist, Lynn Rathbun. Lynn's theme is Whispers and Shouts, referring to the creative process and what issues come from that process. There will be portraits, landscapes, still-lives, and things in between.

ELGIBILITY

- Members and non members of Allied Arts.
- Two dimensional arts accepted.
- All works of art must be executed within the last two years & be original.
- No work will be accepted that is from other artist's work, including photographs or published material.
- Watercolor (includes gouache etc.), oil, acrylic, mixed, pastel, encaustic and collage are accepted.
- Photographs shall have been taken within the last two years.

SALES AND FEES

- Allied Art Association shall retain a 30% commission on sales of local art.
- There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$5.00 per item for Allied Arts members and \$25.00 for non members.
- A flat fee of \$10.00 is required if unable to serve as a docent.
- Only two entries per artist. Only one may be exhibited depending on room.
- All work must be for sale.
- Up to 5 matted pieces per artist may be placed in bins for a single show with an entry fee of \$1.00 each. There is no card fee.
- All work must be picked up on time. \$5.00 a day will be charged for storage. After 30 days it becomes the property of AAA to be disposed of as appropriate.
- Payment for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist's current address at the end of each month for amounts of ten dollars or more.

ARTIST RESPONSIBILITY

- Provide a current biography or artist statement for the Artist Information Binder.
- Artists in the show are expected to help staff the gallery during the show.
- All artwork must be signed in and out on an itemized inventory list by the artist or their agent on exchange days only.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SHOWING WORK

- Paintings must be wired straight across the back, approximately 1/3rd down from the top and the wire must be taut.
- Wrap-around canvasses don't have to be framed if painted on sides & no staples are shown.
- Encaustic paintings don't have to be framed.
- Use acrylic, not glass, for larger paintings.

- AAA reserves the right to reject work which is not dry, not properly wired, or of an inappropriate size and weight. Works that are unsuitable or don't meet the criteria for the show may also be rejected.
- Bin work and cards may be brought in at the same time as other art. Please inquire about Bin/Card Policy on the Web page or gallery for details.
