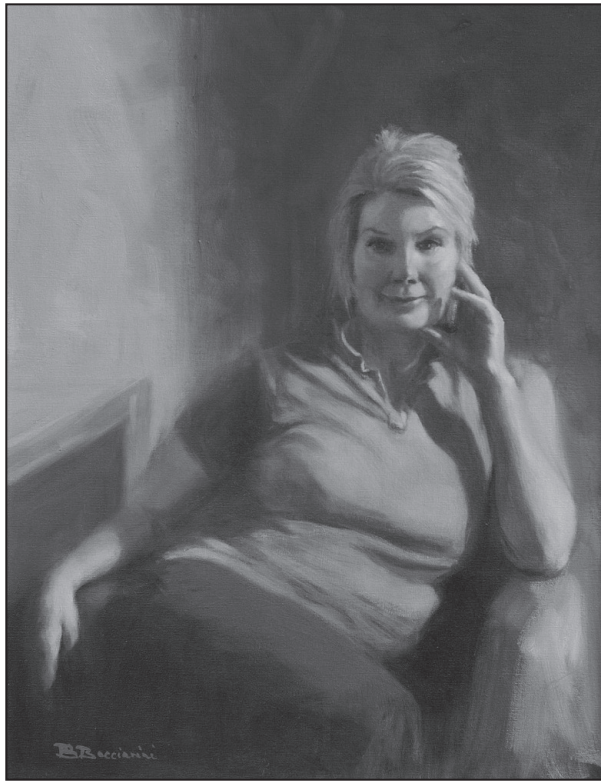
BEAUTY IN THE EYES

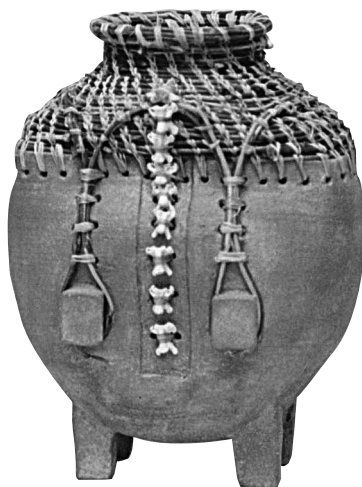

Kellogg's Corner Note from the President...

First, a couple of announcements: We now have beautiful 5" x 9" rack cards which will be placed at the Chamber of Commerce and at various businesses around town. Thank you so much, **Destiny Carter**, for designing them for us! And Allied Arts was the recipient of \$70,000, designated for a scholarship endowment from the George Butterfield Trust. According to the terms of the trust, the interest from the money Allied Arts received must be used for scholarships.

Rabobank currently offers 36-month CDs at 2% APY with the option of increasing the rate within the first 6 months, should Rabobank increase its rate in that time period. This will free up \$1400 per year that we previously gave in scholarships, for use in other areas.

The agenda for our Association meeting (June 5th, 4:00 - 5:30 p.m. at Leffingwell Landing) is quite informal. We hope that folks will drop by to vote on the revised by-laws and to socialize. Most of the recommended changes are minor, bringing the old by-laws (2003) up to date. The revisions were contained in the May newsletter and the existing by-laws are posted on our website. Assuming members ratify the revisions, about the only change most people will notice is that future board elections will occur in October instead of December. Bring a friend, your own beverage, maybe some finger-food and have a good time!

As may be evident, Allied Arts Member Services is continually increasing our efforts to keep members in the know.

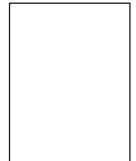
